Expectations of the job:

 - Discuss with the speaker the Library's goals for the Learning Series;
 - Assist the speaker with any audience-related issues and in any ways that will contribute to the success of the course;
 - If necessary, help coordinate resource needs (i.e. projector, screen, audio, computer, microphones). The Library staff is also very helpful in this area;
 - Be the speaker's representative and liaison to the Library;
 - Assist in any other ways you wish (i.e. with publicity and drumming up support for the course);
 - You will not be required to speak. However, it would be best if you could introduce the speaker/teacher and then stay and troubleshoot things during the course.

- Stretch your creative muscles;
