Agreeing not to pursue a relationship after their first date, fate intervenes for two unlikely lovers.

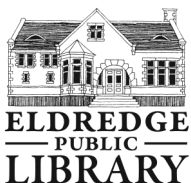

The Outlander Series by Diana Gabaldon

The Third Angel: a Novel by Hoffman, Alice
Follows the lives of three women in love with the wrong men-Madeleine Heller, attracted to her sister's fiancé; Frieda Lewis, the muse to an ill-fated rock star; and Bryn Evans, engaged to be married but secretly obsessed with her ex-husband.

Remember me? by Kinsella, Sophie
Awakening in the hospital after a car crash believing that she is a single, twenty-five-year-old sales associate, Lexi discovers that she has lost three years in her life and she is married to a handsome millionaire, but her perfect new life soon begins to go awry.

The Glass Kitchen: A Novel of Sisters by Linda Francis Lee
The story of a Portia Cuthcart who washed up on the shores of Manhattan and discovers that a kitchen – like an island – can be a refuge. If only she has the courage to give into the pull of love, the power of forgiveness and accept the complications of what it means to be family.

One Plus One by Jojo Moyes

Sundays at Tiffany's by Patterson, James
Years after spending a lonely childhood at the side of a make-believe best friend named Michael, theater maven's daughter Jane encounters a loving flesh-and-blood Michael who is exactly like the figure of her childhood imagination.
