



- **Fridays from 9:45 to 10:45 for Children 18 Mos. to 3 Yrs. — Wee Read Storytime/ Playgroup** This early literacy program includes developmentally appropriate stories, songs, craft and play activities. **Registration and regular attendance is required.**
- **Thursdays at 11:30 for Parents/Caregivers and Newborn to Pre-Crawling Infants — Babies & Books: A PreWee Infant Storytime** It's never too early to share the love of reading with a child. This series of classes will include an age appropriate read-aloud, songs, bounces, chants and fingerplays. Early literacy tips and resources will be shared, as well. **Registration is required. No sessions on the 2nd Thursday of the month to allow for afternoon Itsy Bitsy Yoga program.**
- **Wednesday, March 13th from 2:00 to 3:40 for Students in Grades K to 4 — Movie & Popcorn** Winter isn't over yet!! Join your friends for an afternoon movie on the big screen. **Registration is required. This is an early release day, so a light snack will be provided.**
- **Thursday, March 14th at 4:00 for Newborns to Pre-Crawling Infants — Itsy Bitsy Yoga** Enjoy practicing Yoga, discovering movement, and singing *IBY* rhymes in a child-friendly environment. Join certified IBY instructor Caroline McCutcheon for this unique adult/child bonding opportunity. This *IBY* session will meet the second Thursday of each month. **Registration is required for this program.**
- **Friday, March 15th from 3:45 to 4:45 for Gr. 5 and Up — Jr. Friends Meeting** If you are interested in helping Youth Services, we'll continue to work on projects, and plan upcoming tween/teen programming. **No registration is required.**

- **Saturday, March 23rd at 12:30 for Gr. 3 and 4 (2nd Graders may join with parent/YS permission.) — Chat & Chew** Bring a bag lunch, and join us for a book to film discussion. Books are available at the EPL. **Registration is required.**
- **Saturday, March 23rd at 3:00 for Gr. K to 2 — My FIRST Book Group** This program invites students and adult caregivers to participate in a discussion of the featured title. Books are available at the EPL. **Registration is required.**
