Thank you for considering the Eldredge Public Library for your book donations. All funds from the sale go directly to the library to help purchase equipment and support their wonderful programs for all ages.

We welcome:

- Fiction: Novels, mysteries and thrillers are our biggest sellers. Hardcover and paperbacks published within last 15 years
- Classic literature, biography, cookbooks, gardening, craft and history (no publishing date restriction)
- Media: DVDs, music CDs, audiobook CDs and puzzles
- Children and YA mystery, fiction, & picture books (no board books)
- Art books, “coffee table” books, and local Cape Cod books both fiction and nonfiction.

We cannot accept:

- encyclopedias, large series, medical books or textbooks
- business, self-help, children’s board books
- magazines, audio cassette tapes, or VHS tapes

Please be aware:

Books that smell musty, are stained or are generally in poor and deteriorated shape are books that we can’t sell. Please do not include these items in your donation. This only creates more work for our dedicated volunteers who will have to take these items to the transfer station for recycling.
