

The National African American Read-In is the nation's first and oldest event dedicated to diversity in literature. It was established in 1990 by the Black Caucus of the National Council of Teachers of English (NCTE) to make literacy a significant part of Black History and African American History Month. The National African American Read-in is built on an ambitious yet confident premise: that a school and community reading event can be an effective way to promote diversity in children's literature, encourage young people to read, and shine a spotlight on African American authors.

We have an extraordinary collection of resources waiting for you and your family to enjoy. We hope you join us — pajamas are welcome! We'll have comfy seating, snacks,

and plenty of opportunities for browsing. This is a drop-in program; no registration is required.
