A MESSAGE FROM THE YOUTH SERVICES TEAM



HOW TO REQUEST BOOKS

- Email eldredgecurbside@gmail.com or
- Call 508-945-5170 or
- Request items through the CLAMS Catalog (www.clamsnet.org) and search for items currently available at the Eldredge Public Library.

- Only items currently at the Eldredge Public Library are available for pickup.
- Each library card is limited to 8 requests.
- Be sure to set your pickup location to Eldredge Public Library.
- It may take a few days to fulfill requests due to limited hours & reduced staff.
- You will receive an email or telephone confirmation when your request is ready for pickup - do not travel to the library to pick up items until you receive confirmation.
- Your items will be bagged and placed alphabetically on a table outside the Library's side entrance (on rainy days, items may be picked up just inside the side entrance on Library Lane.)
- You MUST wear a mask and maintain a 6 foot social distance between other patrons during pickup.


